Hobart Police Department (Hobart, Ok) is accepting applications for a full-time Patrol Officer Position.

The Hobart Police Department is proactive and as such we are looking for a candidate who is self-motivated and has a true desire to serve and protect the citizens of our community. Officers are required to perform law enforcement and crime prevention work for the protection of the town, maintain order, enforce state laws and municipal ordinances, and protect life and property within the town. Patrol the city limits of Hobart, provide quality police service to all citizens, visitors, and businesses, and conduct extra patrols of residences and businesses. Respond to emergency and non-emergency calls for service promptly. Officers are required to investigate criminal activity, seek and gather evidence, prepare written incident reports and collision reports, and submit them promptly.

The Hobart Police Department utilizes a 5 on 2 off schedule working 40 hours per week. We are on a two-week pay cycle. Officers rotate shifts quarterly allowing each officer to work every shift. The Hobart Police Department is part of the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System. There is a 1 ½ year probationary period. The Hobart Police Department offers roughly 120 hours of continuing education inhouse each year. Officers will be sent to Basic Instructor Development after their 2-year Certification date. The department requires a 2-year contract for all certified officers and a 4-year contract for nocertified officers, signed at the time of hiring.

- Must be at least 21 years of age and a U.S. citizen
- Must have a High School diploma or GED
- Must possess a valid Oklahoma Driver's License
- Must be able to pass a background investigation
- Must NOT have any felony convictions or major misdemeanor convictions
- Must NOT have any domestic violence convictions
- Must NOT have any pending criminal charges
- Must NOT have any convictions for crimes of moral turpitude
- Must NOT have had a DUI, DWI, or reckless driving violation within the last (5) years
- Must be able to work shift work and holidays
- Highly principled ethics and moral character
- Have a true desire to serve all members of society
- Applicants must pass the written POSSE test
- Must pass a physical agility test
- Must pass a MMPI
- Must pass Oklahoma Police Pension physical
